HOW TO GET THERE

San Francisco (SFO) Airport

Alaska, American, Continental, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, United, and US Airways are just some of the airlines that fly in and out of SFO.

Oakland (OAK) Airport

Alaska, Delta, Southwest, United, and US Airways, among others, fly in and out of OAK.

To get to the hotel from either of these airports, you can rent a car or make arrangements with Airport Express (www.airportexpressinc.com). Prices are \$32 each way. It takes approximately 2 hours to get from each airport to the hotel (and vice versa). The Airport Express website lists the current schedules.

Sonoma County (STS) Airport

Currently Alaska/Horizon is the only airline that flies in and out of STS.

Car rentals, taxis, and Airport Express (see info above) are your alternatives for getting to the hotel from STS.

THINGS TO DO, PLACES TO SEE, AND WHERE TO EAT

The hotel offers on-site massage services and Friday night wine pourings. It also has a pool, Jacuzzi, tennis courts, a fitness center, and a billiard table. The Foxtail Golf Club is adjacent to the hotel and has two 18-hole championship golf courses. The hotel is home to the Bacchus Restaurant & Wine Bar.
